During recess, I help the students in Class 2B to spell words for their dictations. They are hard-working and they have some improvements in English. I am happy that they have improved a lot.


It is a very great experience for me. I can learn a lot while I am helping the P2 students. I am happy to be an English Ambassador.

I love my favourite seasons very much!




A toy shop
